Conditions of Entry

1. The organizing committee reserves its rights, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 611.
2. All classes will be run under all applicable FEI Rules and Regulations or 2019 ESNZ Rules for Eventing.
3. Excessive entries and balloting as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 645
4. All horses in classes 1-4 are required to have either FEI passports or Official ESNZ Identification papers – FEI Article 137.
5. **COMPETITORS - Memberships and Registration conditions.**
Classes 1—3 are reminded that riders and horses must be registered with the FEI before their entries can be accepted, See Article 500 2.4
Classes 1 – 4 = Horses and Riders must have full membership and full equine registration with ESNZ.
6. All horses must be accommodated on the grounds and must be presented for the arrival inspection. Times for this will be available in your acceptance letter.
7. **CLASS 2 and 3 -Young Rider and 7-8 yr. old horse to be awarded to the highest placed young rider and 7-8 yr. old horse in class 2. 1st -Rug and Rosette, 2nd – 4th Rosettes.**
Junior Rider and 6-7 yr. old horse to be awarded to the highest placed young rider and 7-8 yr. old horse in class 3. 1st -Rug and Rosette, 2nd – 4th Rosettes.
8. Payment to be made by internet banking or PayPal at time of entry. Bank Account for Internet Banking 010170 0141658 00
9. **Late payments**—will incur late fee of \$50 if money is not in the bank account on Tuesday the 19th November 2019. Unpaid entries will not be accepted, all entries active or not are subject to pay the compulsory fees once entered.
10. **Unpaid fees** owing from previous Auckland Eventing/Puhinui events will need to be settled before your entry will be accepted.
11. All scratching's must be notified immediately. Refunds before close of entries less \$40 admin charge per horse. There will be no entry fee refunds after the close of entry. Refunds will be paid less \$40 admin charge per entry for horses not meeting the qualifying standard if notified by email before 25th November 2019. No refunds of \$10 or less will be paid. Refunds will be processed between the completion of the event and 1st February 2020. No refunds will be paid after 29th February 2020.
12. **CHANGE OF CLASS, HORSES, OR RIDERS** in classes 1-4 will not be accepted from the Friday the 29th November 2020. Any decisions other than that of the FEI to change after this date will result in the entry being scratched from the event with no refund given. Differences in entry fees will not be refunded.
13. All entry fees and prize money listed in this schedule includes GST
14. Qualifications – For classes 1 - 4 see the ESNZ Eventing website.
15. All yards/Stables are to be left clean and empty, any bedding that has been used is to be removed and paced in allocated muck piles. Riders will be fined \$50 per yard/stable if your allocated yard/stables are left in an unacceptable condition. If you are leaving early and you would like your yard/stable checked before you leave, please contact the stable manager before you depart. Please report any damaged yard/stables to the stable manager throughout the event.
