Entries on the day with late fees.

This a "Derby" competition with a section of 6 - 8 show jumps leading straight onto 7-9 efforts over cross country fences and finishing over a show jump. Competitors will go straight from the show jumping into the cross-country phase, so a Body Protector must be worn for the entirety of the course. The maximum heights are 80cm and 95cm. The optimum time is based on the respective speeds of SJ and XC/per minute at each level. These classes will run as per SJ Table A Article 237. Faults at obstacles will be based on usual SJ and XC faults. The optimum time will not be disclosed, competitors should judge their speed accordingly.

1. Rules are based on ESNZ Eventing rules – this includes horse tack and rider attire for XC.
2. Riders must wear an approved safety helmet, and body protectors must be worn. Back numbers will be available for collection from the office on the day.
3. The classes will run in DRAW order, late entries to ride last in the class. No late entries into a class once that class has started.
4. The organizing committee of Eventing Auckland Inc. reserves the right to make any changes/amendments to the competition or rules.
5. Riders can have full ESNZ membership, introductory membership OR pay a \$10 ESNZ casual membership. Horses are not required to be ESNZ registered.
6. Entries to be made on Equestrian Entries, www.equestrianentries.co.nz Entries close Friday 8th March 2019. Late entries or entries on the day will incur a \$10 late entry fee per horse entered - Cash only accepted on the day, - NO Payment NO Ride!
7. Refunds less 20% if notified before 8th March 2019. time Refunds after this will not be refunded
8. Horses that are not competing are not to be on the grounds. Only competing horses and riders to be riding on the grounds, in the allocated areas.

Classes 1,3,5,7, and 9 will have Ribbons or Rosettes for 1st to 4th place.

Classes 2,4,6,8, and 10 are HC rounds (second round of same height that you have just done).

Maximum of 3 rounds per horse.

Darby will be held at the southern end of the Puhinui Reserve, when you drive in follow the road over the hill past the main arena keep going past the cattle yards and the parking will be on the left at the end.

You must ride in your xc attire with approved safety helmets and back protectors on for SJ as you will go straight out onto the XC from the SJ.

The XC will have 7-9 jumps in it and will enter the main oval.

We will need some volunteers to help us during the day and to pack up at the end, so if you can offer any help that would be great!
