All competitors enter the grounds at their own risk.

NO dogs allowed.

Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money at their discretion.

The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes where insufficient entries are received.

Yards available on the ground \$30.

Camping charge of \$5 per truck or float for entire show. Overnight camping allowed on grounds.

Late entries 50% penalty and start first in Show Jumping and Show Hunter.

Scratching refund is minus 25% if notified by Thursday 08/09/22 and will be at the Committee's discretion. Class changes - refunded 75% of class coming out of and then pay normal fee of class going into.

Prize money for non-series classes will be paid out on 1:7 ratio of starters

ESNZJ & SH Rules and series conditions apply

Ring 1 – Will be run in strict draw order, along with Ring 2 Series classes and FEI Classes

Entries only accepted when accompanied by full payment.

All objections or protests must be lodged in writing within an hour accompanied with a \$50.00 fee. Judicial Committee.

The committee reserves the right to evict & eliminate anyone who is acting in an unacceptable manner.

No classes will be held up if competitors are late, where classes clash competitors will need to choose.

Formal attire to be worn in Ring one and for ESNZ Series Classes while competing. Correct, Tidy attire must be worn whilst walking courses

All Stallions on the grounds including day trippers must be in stallion Yards when not competing. Strict adherence to stallion handling rules will apply. Stallions MUST be supervised at all times.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Equestrian Park.

All Yarded & Stabled equines are to have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and / or rugs as per Jumping Rules 200.7.1 17.

Helmets must be worn on motorbikes at all times and No riding after dark

If show is cancelled competitors will be refunded full entry fees less 10% retained for admin purposes.

All Horses and riders have to be registered with ESNZ, if entering Series and age group classes, Casual Memberships will be accepted

### **ESNZ Registration & Membership Requirements**

All horses and ponies competing in show jumping and show hunters must pay the \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy.

Riders who are not current members of the ESNZ can compete at Introductory Level only at \$15.88 or the day

For Horses/Ponies WITHOUT current ESNZ Equine Registration - \$20 (includes \$15 Flexi-Start)

For Horses/Ponies WITH current ESNZ Equine Registration but no Jumping/Show Hunter Discipline Start - \$15 Flexi-Start Horses are restricted to 1.10m and Under. Ponies are restricted to 1.00m and Under. Horses/Ponies not eligible to start in Series Classes.

All other classes, Riders must have a full ESNZ membership, horses must be fully ESNZ registered and have an ESNZ Jumping annual start.

All competitors must wear an ESNZ/RAS approved helmet as identified by the current tag system at all times when riding

### **Show Hunter Conditions 2022**

PRACTISE ROUNDS - Saturday only - start 8:00 am (both Rings) \$3 at the gate.

All Show Hunter Competition will be run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2022 & Equitation Series Conditions 2022

Refer to ESNZ web site for Show Hunter Rule changes. Equines competing in Show Hunter Series Classes must have full ESNZ Registration and a Current Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start.

- Equines competing using the ESNZ Jumping Casual Levy cannot compete in ANY Show Hunter Series Classes. 'Introductory Classes' and do not carry HOY qualifying points.
- ESNZ Community members may only compete in Introductory Classes.
- Category C Please note: Some Category C Classes may run in the Horse Show Hunter Ring at the completion of Saturdays Horse Classes.

- Classes may be run back to back

## Pukahu Show Adult Riding Club Section

Saturday 10am – Flat Fee \$60 (includes Ground Fee, Medic Fee and Admin Fee)

Hosted by PARC (Pukahu & Hawke's Bay Adult Riding Club)

All competitors must be current financial members of an Adult Riding Club (ARC) affiliated to New Zealand Riding Clubs Inc. (NZRC) Please indicate your membership at time of entry. There are two separate rings, namely one encouragement ring for recreational riders only, and the other to cater for riders who have experience in showing, dressage, eventing etc. Experienced riders on green horses should choose the Competitors ring. Adults may ride ponies without prejudice. Helmets must be red tagged and whips must be no more than 76cm long. Competitors must choose either Hunter Type or Show Horse Type – a horse or pony cannot be both. Winners from the Adult Riding Club Mount classes from each ring to ride off for Supreme Champion ARC Mount.

## **HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY**

This event is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all staff, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

Providing a safe event, safe equipment, and proper materials.

Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of eliminate, isolate, or minimise. • Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices.

Complying with all health and safety legislation, regulations, and codes of practice. We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy. EVERY PERSON involved in our show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:

Being involved in the event health and safety system.

Following correct procedures. • Ensuring safe and proper use of equipment. • Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.

Not tying horses up to floats or trucks on the grounds. • Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.

Ensuring ALL accidents and incidents are reported to the Health & Safety Officer at the Show Secretary's office.

Helping new employees, trainees, and visitors to understand the safety procedures and why they exist.

Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns. • Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

COMPETITORS are responsible for themselves at ALL times and must observe the safe practices and the rules/instructions relating to their competition. In case of a fall of a rider and/or horse at any time in the competition arena, in the practice arena, or elsewhere within the grounds of the event, the rider must be checked by the event's medical service and the check recorded on your event medical check card before taking part in the round in progress or in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224). The card must remain in your pocket and be presented to the gate steward or ground committee before continuing to compete. The horse must be cleared by the Veterinarian or President of the Ground Jury and one other official if the Veterinarian is not available, before the equine is permitted to take part in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224).

Pukahu & District sports Club complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be removed from the event. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider and makes an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the Blue Card process (outlined below). ESNZ's Blue Card process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care. Blue Card process:

Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion.

If a rider issued with a Blue Card at an event refuses to withdraw from the event, disciplinary action may be taken through the disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.

The Blue Card notice is logged on a rider's profile on ESNZ's database.

A Blue Card means that a rider is stood down from all riding activities until clearance from a registered GP or registered medical specialist can be obtained.

If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without first providing medical clearance, this may result in disciplinary action taken through the ESNZ disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
