Horses can be registered with Endurance Start (if you want kms and results to be recorded) or Unregistered horses pay a \$10 flexi start fee per competition.

25km/15km Intro Endurance and Novice CTR - Rider can be an Introductory, Full or unregistered. Unregistered riders must pay an additional ESNZ day membership fee of \$15
