## ESNZ Membership:

40km Novice Endurance and Open, Intermediate, Junior CTR - Rider must be an Introductory or Full member of ESNZ as well as a member of an ESNZ affiliated Endurance club. Horses can be registered with Endurance Start (if you want kms and results to be recorded) or Unregistered horses pay a \$10 flexi start fee per competition.

25km/15km Intro Endurance and Novice CTR - Rider can be an Introductory, Full or unregistered. Unregistered riders must pay an additional ESNZ day membership fee of \$15

## Ride base directions

- Lion's Back. 5650 State Highway 1, Seddon. 4km South of Seddon, on the right hand side. You go up over the big Lion's Back saddle and down the other side, and the base is just over the bridge. It is signed "Lion's Back".
- There is no camping on base as this is not a secured paddock. If you are coming from away and need to camp you can do so at the Ward Showgrounds/PC grounds – there are yards, toilets and showers (let Heidi know if you require this). Please keep your horses under supervision at all times while on ride base at this venue.
- There is water at ride base and on the ride.
