ESNZ EVENTING LEAD OFFICIAL – JUDGES LIAISON

Ultimately reports to the Chair of ESNZ Eventing Board

Key Tasks:

- Provide advice to the Sport Manager and the Board around matters pertaining to the roles and functions of Judges and Judging in the sport.
- Provide advice around rule changes & other communication with the FEI
- Be a key liaison person for all Judges in the sport
- Provide encouragement, mentoring, support and advice for other Judges and those looking to become Judges
- Ensure that there are sufficient competent Judges, qualified at the appropriate levels, for the sport to function throughout NZ
- Provide help with planning and implementation of regional seminars for judging qualifications
- Help with identifying talent in the judging area and providing opportunities for this talent to progress through the sport, including to FEI and International levels
- Work with the Sport Manager to ensure that there are sufficient qualified, competent judges coming through to allow FEI Events to function in NZ at the required numbers for horse and rider progression
- Provide recommendations around judging for FEI Events and Championships
- Keep abreast of, and help with the adoption of, International safety standards for the sport in NZ
- Provide advice to Organising committees regarding Official procurement and organisational issues of a Technical nature
