Saturday 18th & Sunday 19th December Dannevirke ride (on the way to Weber)

Directions: By the BP in Dannevirke, **turn to the south into Miller St** (becomes Weber Road). **Travel 15 km then turn right into Lys Road** (directly after a bridge over the Mangatoro River; previous turn off on the left is Ngapaeruru Rd), ride base is approx. 2 kms up this metal road.

Registration requirements:

- 80 km rides – horse and rider must be ESNZ registered (rider needs full ESNZ membership)
- 40 & 60 km rides – rider must have at least Intro ESNZ membership, \$10 flexi-fee if horse not registered
- 20 & 10 km rides - \$15 casual day membership if rider is not an ESNZ member, horse needs no registration
- Lead rein – \$15 casual day membership if rider is not an ESNZ member, horse needs no registration; person leading (walking) doesn't need any membership.

It is likely that only COVID vaccinated individuals (riders, friends and volunteers) will be able to attend due to the new COVID risk framework that will be in place. We will be following all other relevant COVID restrictions.
