2.3 Horses & Riders

b)

Open level 1 changed from 80 – 99km, to 100 – 119km to bring in line with FEI Rules.

Addition of *Open Level 3 Horses and riders that have successfully completed at least one Open competition of 140-160km.*

Application to Endurance NZ board for approval outside of under 18.

2.8 **Lead Rein Class**

Removed "must start after all other rides". Sometimes it works better not to.

Novice Classes, Minimum competition times must be set for each phase, along with a maximum overall ride time.

Ratification of the addition added at start of season,

Maximum competition times for Open Classes to be set as an overall ride time, no individual phase times will be set.

2.17 Multi Day Endurance Competitions

d) Officials may change each day, so long as they are suitably qualified.

Combinations entered in an Elevator class must choose not to elevate at these set times:

within 40 minutes of completion of the final phase of the first day or following the full veterinary inspection at the beginning of the second day.

to clear up confusion around Elevator/Multi Day.

Change 6

2.19.1 Yarding

d) Stallions must have an approved solid or pipe yard displaying a STALLION sign, with a contact number of the person responsible. All stallion yards are to be a minimum height of 1.2 metres.

Amended to include contact number to correct wording from Stallion rules.

e) Solid/pipe yards may be divided with two strands of tape which do not need to be electrified, to allow for two horses within the yard

removed as seems absurd.

2.19.2 Identification:

Change from

It is mandatory for all horses to have halters on while they are in their yards. All horses MUST have identification on them at all times, whether in their yards or not.

To

All horses MUST have identification on them at all times, halters, saddles or other tack that is not likely to come off in the event of a fall.

Amended to include identification on track.
