- Payment must be received in Show Jumping Canterbury's account by closing date to avoid late fees.
- Please provide bank account name and number for direct credit of prize money and refunds

**FEES TO BE ADDED TO ENTRY FEES**

NEC FEES (yarding/camping/power) – Please add on all extra nights to your show entry to cover the night(s) prior or after the show you may also be attending. This will be policed by NEC Officials from now on.

Also a note that even if you are a member of NEC they still require you to pay the ground fees at competitions.

Stabling: First in and paid get allocation priority. You cannot only book 1 night with your stabling request.

- Ground Fees \$20 / horse for 1 day or \$25 / horse for 2 days
- Open Yards \$20 for show, Maximum 2 days/nights, extra day/nights @ \$10
- Covered Yards \$50 for show, Maximum 2 day/nights, extra day/nights @ \$25
- Stables and Stallions \$60 for show, Maximum 2 nights, extra nights @ \$30
- Non-powered Camping \$20 for show PER FAMILY PLEASE (this covers loos, showers etc)
- Powered Camping \$25 / night – include all nights staying including prior and after the event.
- Admin Fee \$15 / RIDER (covers First Aid, expenses etc) Non-refundable
- Jumping/Show Hunter Levies See below table

**ESNZ JUMPING AND CASUAL LEVIES 2020-2021**

- \$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory)

Payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Show Hunter.

- \$20 Casual Jumping Levy for Equines

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy. The levy is \$20 for the show.

Can jump up to 1.00m on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

### **SHOW CONDITIONS**

- Run under ESNZ rules and Show Jumping New Zealand Rules, for Series conditions Refer to Annex 1 1 (SJ Rule Book).
- Prizes & Conditions for all South Island Series will be on the Canterbury Show Jumping Facebook Page.
- Competitors and spectators attending this competition do so at their own risk. Show Jumping Canterbury and the organiser's disclaim all liability in the event of accident/injury/damage to riders, horses, spectators, or property.
- All injuries and accidents anywhere on the grounds must be reported to the office.
- Dress code: Formal required in R1 & R2, Minimum in R3 as per ESNZ Jumping Rules
- The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any class or prize money.
- Prize money will be paid out as per the schedule and then on a ratio of 1:7.
- Manual entries must be made on official ESNZ entry forms and include horse & rider registration numbers.
- Please refer to the "Registration guide" on the ESNZ website for more information
- CLASS CHANGES: 80% of the original class will be refunded and full fee of new class payable for ALL changes. Changes MUST BE DONE BEFORE the jump sheets have left the office.
- Late entries: Plus 50%. This includes all late payments. 50% of unpaid entries as at closing date will be added to your entry.
- No refunds payable for entries received after closing date of entries.
- Scratching's: to be advised by 7am each day for that day's competition.
- Changes to the First Class each day to be advised by 7am each day for that day's competition.
- Refunds are only applied less 20% per horse/pony upon presentation of medical / veterinary certificate or at the discretion of the organising committee.
- Hacks / Ponies may start in only ONE Championship class or Mini Prix or Grand Prix.
- DOGS ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES
- The Show Jumping Canterbury Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry
- Coffee cart & food will be available on the grounds.
- By entering or attending you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that SJ Canterbury approve in attendance to cover the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there might be livestreaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day

- It is the rider's responsibility to clean up all hay and manure from their yards/covered yards/stables as well as from around their float/truck, which is to be placed in designated areas NOT around trees. Any holes dug by horses MUST also be filled in. If a stable/covered yard is not sufficiently cleaned out, you will not be able to use one at our next show and you will receive a \$25 fine.
- **YARDING ALLOCATIONS:** For all yarding apart from Leased Yards and Stallions, these will be allocated on **FIRST IN AND PAID** basis only! No payment and you will not be allocated anything until payment is made in full.
- Riders must wear tagged helmets and must always be done up whether competing or training at any time on the grounds. Article 151 will be enforced. As per ESNZ Rules
- **Concussions:** Any rider that falls or has a knock to the head, must be checked by St Johns before remounting. Any rider deemed to be concussed will not be allowed to ride for the rest of the show.
- Official Photographers assigned to the event by SJ Canterbury organising committee are the only media to be sold.
- **JOB SELECTION:** All Canterbury Area Riders **MUST ENTER A HELPERS JOB** Class in the Jobs Section when entering online. Once your job is confirmed, it is then up to the rider to find a replacement if they scratch after entry closing date. If a job is not selected your entries will be **DECLINED**. There will be a sign in and out procedure in the office for all jobs. \$80.00 fine for those who do not complete their job in full. Job Descriptions are available from the Event Secretary.
- **BACK NUMBERS:** Please collect your back number from the office before you start. Your back number will be flagged if there are any fees outstanding or no job selected. If payment or job selection is required, you will need to internet bank and show proof to the Event Secretary before being given your back number.
- Any changes in Covid-19 Levels and Show Jumping Canterbury and NEC Christchurch's Covid-19 Health and Safety policies will be implemented and all riders must abide by these in full.
- **\*\*NEW RULE\*\*** All equines while not being ridden, **MUST** have their name, name of person responsible and their telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rug Article 200 7.1 as per ESNZ Rules.

### **Class 60 – Gentleman Rider Class      Sponsored by Tavern Harewood**

Open to all Gentlemen Riders over the age of 18 at the time of the show. Run over our 3 Canterbury Shows. New format – please enter this class **YOURSELF** with your nominated mount and any points will be awarded for your results at each show. Please note, no Ring 3 classes are eligible, however all other classes in the other 2 SJ and 2 SH rings can be counted. Only 1 mount per rider to be nominated.

### **Class 61 – Ring 3 Equitation Prizes      Sponsored by Concrete Power**

Equitation prizes will be awarded to 1 horse combination and 1 pony combination for each day of the competition. They will be judged on overall turnout of horse and rider, ring craft, and potential to progress in the sport of show jumping. Riders also competing in any other rings on any mount are not eligible. All those Ring 3 only riders are automatically eligible (no charge), however please indicate by entering Class 61, Ring 3 only at time of your online entry. Rosettes will be awarded at the conclusion of the horse/pony section on each day.

## **Show Hunter Classes 2020-2021**

- Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2020, & SHNZ Equitation Series Conditions 2020
- All horses/ponies may start in any class under the Casual Start system with the exception of Series Classes where horses/ponies must hold an annual jumping start registration
- Horses with an annual start registration will gain HoYQ points in classes designated HoYQ – note that qualifying for HoY is now a condition of entry not a rule
- Rising Star Series – Sponsored by Marriott Stables and Young Horse Series – Sponsored by Rosewood Livery
  - New Rising Star rules – a rising star is a horse that has had three or fewer wins in a recognized SH class at the start of the current season
  - Run over three shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
  - Three classes qualify per show – under saddle and two jumping classes
