The Health and Safety Policy is in the Show Secretary's office. By entering the show, you accept our Health and Safety Conditions. Please make yourself aware of them.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

- 1. Entries will only be accepted with full payment of entry and all other fees.
- 2. All classes run under ESNZ rules current at the time of the show
- 3. All riders compete at their own risk.
- 4. All riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership and will not be allowed to start if they are not current.
- 5. The committee reserves the right to alter the program and prizemoney if necessary
- 6. Class 6 horse 1.05m 1.10m is only open to those horses entered in other classes during the show.
- 7. One start per horse on Sunday
- 8. World Cup Class conditions Entry Fee \$620 (includes WC class entry, stable for the duration of the event and a start in one of the stipulated classes on Friday)

As per World Cup rules, to qualify for the World Cup Class, the horse and rider must complete a full round in either of the following classes on Wednesday 1 Nov - class 3 (1.40m) or class 4 (Young rider Series) or class 5 (1.30m).

Horses failing to complete one of these classes will be ineligible to compete in the World Cup Class, however may enter another class at no cost. All horses are then required to stay on the grounds until the completion of competition.

All horses competing in FEI classes (World Cup and 1*) will have an Arrival Inspection Wednesday Afternoon. Times to be advised. All horses competing in the World Cup will trot up on Thursday morning. Times to be advised.

All horses competing in the FEI 1* will trot up on Friday morning. Times to be advised.

- All class changes must be made within 30mins of the last class finishing the previous day (not including any evening entertainment classes). Class changes will incur a \$10 fee per change. The preferred option of any class changes is to complete them online through Evoevents.co.nz
- 10. Refund less 20% for scratchings made prior to 7pm on the Monday before the show. No refunds for any other scratchings except on the production of a medical or vet certificate, in which case a refund less 20% will be processed. A \$100 stabling fee will be retained on top of the 80% refund if no medical or vet certificate is provided after the entry is received.
- 11. Any damage caused to the stables or any other facility during the event must be communicated to show secretary or the stabling manager immediately.

12. Strictly no dogs allowed! This includes in vehicles (horse trucks included)

- 13. No horses to be tied to trucks or outside of stables. Limited day horse accommodation is available depending on entries. Please book and pay for with your entry.
- 14. Horses not competing during the weekend are not permitted to stay on the grounds.
- 15. Stables are limited. Please be aware that if you are a local, you may be asked to travel each day. A waitlist for stabling will apply. With the exception of FEI Horses that must remain on the grounds until the completion of competition.
- 16. Formal dress code in all rings/classes.
- 17. The Riders bar is open daily. Any alcohol purchased elsewhere must not leave the truck park area.
- 18. All yarded and stabled equines must have a name tag visible with contact details as per the ESNZ Jumping rules.
- 19. Stables and day yards must be left clean (manure and hay) on departure. A \$100 stabling bond will be charged per competitor. A cable tie will be supplied to your stable, please tie shut upon departure once your stable is clean and tidy. Bond refunds will be processed for all competitors that pass the stabling inspection completed by the stabling manager at the completion of the show.
- 20. Truck parking please park as close as possible in the truck park.
- 21. Please note, when booking a powered site that there is no allowance for any awnings, tents or gazebos next to your truck. This will need to be pre arranged with the stabling manager.
- 22. Warm up arenas will be open 1 hr prior to competition starting with priority given to competing horses in the final 15mins. Warm up arenas will be open 1hr after competition finishing for the day (not including evening classes)
