1. The Springbush Committee reserves the right to alter the programme, classes and prize money, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 611 – RESERVATION OF RIGHT.
2. Article 610 – DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Neither the Organiser of any event to which these rules apply nor the NF nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to Horses, owners, Athletes, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.
3. Classes will be run under ESNZ Eventing Rules Version 9 and FEI Eventing Rules effective 1 January 2025.
4. FEI classes will need to fulfil the FEI Horse Health Requirements.
5. Excessive entries and balloting as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 645
6. NO Dogs.
7. Classes 1 - 2 both Horse and Rider must have current (2025) FEI Rider Membership and Horse Registration
8. Classes 1 - 4 Riders must have full ESNZ rider membership. Classes 1 - 3 Horses must have full ESNZ equine registration.
9. Classes 5 - 6 Riders can use Introductory ESNZ Membership. Class 6 Riders can use Casual Membership \$16.30.
10. Class 4 Horses can use ESNZ Discipline Start Flexi \$16.50. Class 4 - 6 Horses can use ESNZ Casual Equine Registration \$5.15
11. COMPULSORY ENTRY REQUIREMENT – Every entry MUST supply at least 1 volunteer.
12. YARDS and CAMPING; please take your rubbish home with you. Some paddocks available to MULTIPLE horses only please note on your entry if you wish to have a paddock. Paddocks are still to be mucked out and left clean.
13. NO Non-competitive horses on the grounds at any time.
14. Payment to be made by PayPal or Stripe (credit card) at time of entry.
15. Late payments - Unpaid entries are not accepted, all entries active or not are subject to pay compulsory fees once entered. Unpaid/unaccepted entries will incur late fees of \$40 if entry is accepted by payment after the close of entries.
16. Scratchings/Refunds/Prize Money. -All scratchings are to be done through Evo Events. Scratchings must be notified immediately, as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 646. Withdrawals to be done at the office once the event has started. REFUNDS: Scratching from the event after entries have closed and 48 hours before start of competition (before 8.00am Thursday 20th FEB 2025) will be entitled to an 50% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate. NO refunds will be given for scratching's after this time, no exceptions. Requests for refunds including vet and medical certificates, need to be emailed to the secretary before 24th FEB 2025 to request a refund. All Refunds will be processed between the completion of the event and 1st April 2025.
17. CANCELLATION DUE TO AN EXTREME WEATHER EVENT If, in the Organising Committee's reasonable opinion an Extreme Weather Event, after close of entries and prior to the start of the event, causes event cancellation, a minimum of 50% of entry fees will be refunded.
