#### INTRODUCTION

Dressage NZ welcomes you to the Bates Saddles NZ Dressage Championships, the Webb Equestrian NZ Para Equestrian Championships and the Livamol FEI Dressage World Challenge 2022. Dressage NZ, ESNZ Para Equestrian and all event participants owe a huge vote of thanks to the outstanding support from event sponsors who will join us in November. This is a first for NZL to have the World Challenge run alongside these events. Riders should only enter the World Challenge classes on notification of their selection. These classes will be added to EvoEvents at selection date for riders to pay and confirm their WDC entry, but riders may submit all Championship entries at any time and add the WDC class later. WDC Nominations are open until 2/10/22. Refer to WDC information on page 23

#### PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE

The horse inspection for the World Challenge will take place on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> at approx 3.30 pm following WDC arena familiarisation. Provisionally all other arena familiarisation will be at 4pm – 6pm. All competitions will commence on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> with WDC competitions taking priority on Thursday and combinations competing in other classes up to Advanced being drawn accordingly. Prix St Georges and Int I may only compete in one test per day on Thursday.

#### COVID 19 POLICY

#### COVID 19 REFUND POLICY

In addition to the non-refundable \$70 rider fee:

Should the Covid levels change from orange, to a more restrictive level, there may be a need to cancel the show once entries have been received. Refunds will be applied in the following manner:

1. Cancellation of show before close of entries - full refund of all class entry fees, and stabling/camping fees. No refund of Admin or EVO Event Fees
2. Cancellation notified after close of entries but on or before 12th November 2022 - full refund of all stabling/camping fees, 50% refund of class entry fees, no refund of Admin or Evo Event Fees.
3. Cancellation notified after 12<sup>th</sup> November 2022 but on or before 21<sup>st</sup> November 2022 - full refund of all stabling/camping fees, 25% refund of class entry fees, no refund of Admin or Evo Event Fees.
4. Cancellation notified after on or after Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022 – refunds at discretion of OC.

## **HEALTH & SAFETY**

**ENTRIES:** All entry payments must be made at time of entry via Poli-Pay ONLY . Entries will not be released into the system without payment of all fees.

**RESPONSIBILITY FOR SCHEDULE CONDITIONS:** It is the responsibility of the rider, person responsible and /or person making any entry to have read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

**RULES JURISDICTIONS: PROTESTS & COMPLAINTS:** Please refer to the ESNZ General Regulations (current as at date of event) for the process for lodging protests or complaints. No protest or complaint will be accepted unless this process is followed. The official finish time of the event is sixty minutes after the completion of the last scheduled official activity of the event including any prize giving.

**RULES & POLICIES:** All ESNZ and ESNZ Dressage rules, Para Equestrian Rules and policies which apply at all times and /or from time of arrival on the grounds, including but not limited to: Welfare of the Horse, ESNZ Code of Conduct, ESNZ Behaviour Policy, instruction from members of the organising committee, prohibited gear, horse welfare, etc are applicable prior to the official event start time. ESNZ Members are responsible for the behaviour of any non-members that are associated with their entry eg grooms, family members, support team.

**OFFICIAL EVENT START TIME: 7am Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November.** This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules and ESNZ Para Equestrian/Dressage rules and ESNZ policies including Code of Conduct, but also note no illegal gear may be used from time of arrival on the grounds

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## **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

### **1. Equine Therapists and Treatment**

a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarians and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must register their attendance with the Organising Committee prior to any treatment to the event.

All equine therapists must be appropriately qualified in the field they are offering services and should be able to provide verification if requested

b. All therapists and practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.

c. Riders who own their equipment (e.g. Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.

d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event may be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

**2. OTHER PROFESSIONALS/TRADERS** Any other professional intending on providing services or trade of any kind at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professional Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors and grooms that are in part or full-time employment of a competitor.

## RULES & EVENT CONDITIONS SUMMARY:

This must be read in conjunction with ESNZ Dressage Rules v8 Eff 1/9/2022

**Rules:** All competitions will be run under the current version ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage (v9 1/9/22) and ESNZ Para Equestrian Dressage rules where applicable.

1. **Prohibited Saddlery:** ESNZ Dressage Rule 478.9: Prohibited gear is not permitted from the time of arrival at the venue.
2. **Riding Helmets:** ESNZ yellow or red-tagged, approved riding helmets must be worn at all times when mounted at the National Equestrian Centre.
3. **Horse/Pony ID Numbers (DR Art 477):** Approved Horse/Pony official identification numbers must be worn on both sides of the horse/pony at all times during warm up and competition, and when being ridden or led in arena familiarization. ID Tag with Horse Name, Rider phone contact must be worn in or out of the stable/yard at all other times.
4. **Schedule Amendments:** The OC reserves the right to alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ GR's/ESNZ Dressage NZ Rules.
5. **Equal Placings: (DR Art 446)** In the case of equality in any class at this event, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
6. **Commanded Tests:** All tests must be ridden from memory, unless a commander is appointed for any young horse class.
7. **Prize Money: DR article 465 & Under Special Conditions Art 464.** The OC reserves the right to adjust the advertised Prize Money.
8. **Special Conditions:** Championship Prize Money will be paid on Championship points (not individual classes). The OC reserves the right to amend/limit the number of prizes or prize money if less than eight starters in any championship or class. Up to 3 starters, 1<sup>st</sup> only; 4-5 starters 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>; 6-8 starters 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>; 9 or more 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup>, and/or pay prize money which is less than the entry fee for 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> place getters.
9. **Presentation of Prizes:** Approximate presentation times will be advised in the programme and are subject to change at any time, please check with event administration for updates. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies or prizes/trophies should a place getter not attend an advertised prize giving. Only Riders with conflicting classes may nominate another person to the Prize Giving Co-ordinator to collect prizes/rosettes at the prizegiving. This also applies to series winners and place getters
10. **Media & Publicity:** ESNZ Dressage NZ reserves the right to use event photographs for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications and other promotions as they see fit. ESNZ Dressage reserves the right to record and broadcast via live stream or any other type of digital broadcast any or all of the competition at the Bates National Dressage Championships 2022, both during and after the event. Competitions and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All footage remains the property of ESNZ Dressage. The copyright of all photographer's work must always be respected by competitors and their associates during and after the event and may not be used without permission of the photographer.



## STABLE & YARD ALLOCATIONS

1. The OC requests that all riders respect that there is limited covered horse accommodation at the venue. Every effort will be made by the OC to allocate preferred accommodation to competing horses. In some instances, this may not be possible. Allocations will be made in principle as follows.
  2. A number of stables and covered yards will be reserved for and allocated to stallions, National Equestrian Centre lease holders (all Levels), South Island combinations and those from north of Whangarei (all levels), Advanced to Grand Prix level horses. It will be notified on the Bates Nationals Facebook page as soon as possible when covered accommodation is full. Riders may request an upgrade should covered yards become available after this time. Priority for these riders will ONLY BE HELD UNTIL 11 OCTOBER 2022.
  3. Priority will also be given to WDC riders. Riders who intend to compete in the Nationals and have nominated for WDC should put their entries in as soon as possible. Priority for these riders will ONLY BE HELD UNTIL 11 OCTOBER 2022.
  4. **Note to National Equestrian Centre lease holders:** Your lease must be current at time of entry, until the 26<sup>th</sup> November 2022 or preferred yarding will not be allocated.
  5. Any non-allocated stables / covered yards as above will be allocated in order of receipted / paid entry from the entry opening day. Therefore, competitors from Prelim to Advanced Medium who require covered horse accommodation should enter as soon as possible after entry opening date.
  6. The OC will endeavor to keep horses from the same rider, team or family together, but this is not guaranteed
  7. Competitors who live within 45 minutes of the venue are encouraged to return to their home base if possible please to assist the covered yarding situation.

## ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. **At the time of entry** all competitors must be current ESNZ full or child members current through to 26<sup>th</sup> November 2022.
2. **At the time of entry**, all horse/pony registrations must be current to the 26<sup>th</sup> November 2022.
3. All entries are subject to a \$70 non-refundable Event Fee per rider.
4. All horses/ponies must have a current annual dressage start Eligibility: Art 461, 462 & 462A Eligibility is the responsibility of the person responsible or competitor.
5. Only entries received at [www.evoevents.co.nz](http://www.evoevents.co.nz) by midnight Sunday 16 October 2022 with all fees paid will be accepted. Payment can be made by Poli-Pay. Credit card payments will attract a card transaction fee. NO Postal, fax, emailed or phone entries accepted.
6. **Music for Freestyle classes.** All riders must email the music for their freestyle by **Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2022**. Music cannot be brought direct to the event Music must be emailed to [yoursoundandlighting@gmail.com](mailto:yoursoundandlighting@gmail.com). A wav. file is the preferred format, however an mp3 file is also acceptable.
7. **Downgraded horses/ponies:** Downgraded horses/ ponies **may compete** within twelve months of being downgraded except in classes which count for ESNZ Open Championship titles and ESNZ National Trophies  
*Explanation: DR Art 463 specifies that downgraded horses or ponies may not compete in any National Championship competition within twelve months of downgrading. Downgraded horses and ponies may compete in all competitions (classes)but are not eligible for any open championship points*  
**Super 5 League: Downgraded horses and ponies may compete in Super 5 League qualifiers but may not gain series points within 12 months of being downgraded.**
8. **Fees:** Payment of all fees is required at time of entry. Entries are not considered to be definite until payment has been made. Payment at time of entry is the responsibility of the person making the entry, **NO** payment reminders will be issued by the OC.
9. Horses may be entered in one level only, exclusive of Young Dressage Horse Age Group Championships and Super 5 League qualifiers.
10. **Entries** If any class is oversubscribed, further entries will be put on a waitlist. Any combination on a waitlist who does not get a start will receive a refund
11. **Upgradings:** Must be notified to the Entry Secretary within two working days of the horse upgrading and changes requested on EvoEvents. Failure to do so prior to the event will result in no refund and additional entry fees charged.
12. **Entry Changes:** Other requests for changes after close of entry may be made but will be subject to the approval of the OC. A fee of \$25 per class will be applicable if approved.
13. **Horses not Entered:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official event start time must be entered at the event unless special permission is granted by the OC. Covered yards/stables will not be given priority to horses not entered at the event.
14. **Non ESNZ Registered Horses:** No ESNZ non-registered horses or ponies will be permitted on the event grounds unless special permission is granted by the OC. This permission must be sought at time of entry.
15. **Helen Holden Memorial Trophy Area Teams entries** must be nominated by Area Delegates or their delegated representative and emailed to the Event Secretary by 5pm Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2022.

## GENERAL VENUE CONDITIONS

### Stables, Yards & Wash Down Bays

1. Moving horses to yards or stables not prior allocated to those horses is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager
2. Any temporary yarding supplied by competitors must comply with ESNZ rules location to be approved by Stable Manager
3. All yards and stables are to be left clean, free of all horse waste & hay and properly mucked out. A \$100 administration and cleaning fee will apply if left uncleaned. **It is recommended all riders take a photo of their cleaned out yard clearly showing their yard number on departure**
4. All stable muck to be disposed of on muck heaps.
5. Please use the wheelie bins provided for rubbish only
6. Keep wash down bays clean at all times.
7. No smoking or vaping in any NEC buildings or stable & covered yard areas.

### Dogs

1. Dogs must be kept in the truck park and on a lead at all times.
2. No dogs are allowed in any stable or yarding areas, warm up, competition areas or buildings.
3. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition.
4. Failure to comply with the above rulings will result in a \$100 fine which must be paid for by the dog owner.
5. This owner must pay this fine to be allowed to continue riding in the competition.

### Vehicles

Combinations wishing to enter the Para Equestrian classes must have a Full Classification and have qualified as a combination with a score of 58% or higher achieved in the FEI Team or FEI Individual test for their Grade gained since 1 January 2021 at any event sanctioned by Dressage NZ and run under ESNZ Para Equestrian Rules.

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

***Refer to General Conditions for the event plus for Para Classes please note:***

1. These conditions are to be read in conjunction with the remainder of this event schedule and all conditions apply to Para Equestrian entries.
2. This event is run under ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules, ESNZ General Rules and Regulations and DNZ Dressage Rules.
3. All competitors must be current ESNZ full riding or child members current until 26 November 2022 at the time of entry.
4. All horse registrations must be current to 26 November 2022 at the time of entry.
5. ESNZ, Dressage NZ & ESNZ Para-Equestrian rules apply from time of arrival. Official event start time as stated in this schedule.
6. All Riders are to display the Official Orange Para Badge on each side of their saddle cloth at all times while schooling, hacking or competing as well as the horse's ESNZ registration number on both sides of the bridle or saddle cloth
7. Athletes may compete in a maximum of 3 tests per day per horse at the event.
8. All tests are the current 2022 versions that are at FEI.org [Para Dressage Tests | FEI](https://www.fei.org/Para-Dressage-Tests)
9. A horse may not be shared by different riders between PE & AB classes.
10. A horse may be shared by riders of different Grades in Para classes as per Article 125.
11. While every effort will be made to accommodate riders wishing to compete in both PE & AB classes and to accommodate PE riders with more than one horse, the smooth running of the event is paramount and should there be excessive entries or timetabling issues, then riders may be asked to nominate which horse/discipline they want to compete in.
12. Depending on indoor timetable requirements classes may be held in a different daily order.
13. A Riders' Briefing will be held time and place to be advised. All riders are required to attend.
14. **All Three Tests** count toward the title for each grade as per Article 144.
15. Prize giving times to be confirmed and will be announced during the event.

## **PARA EQUESTRIAN TEAMS EVENT**

1. Open to all riders entering the Para Equestrian classes. If riders wish to not participate then please notify in the General Comments section of your entry.
2. Teams of 3 riders.
3. Team will be randomly selected at the close of entries via an online team selector.
4. Riders on multiple horses will be drawn a spot on each horse unless numbers dictate uneven teams in which case the second horse will be placed on a waiting list in order of time the entry was made.

## Format of the Competition

40 horses / ponies plus 5 reserves will be named across the 5 sections except that Dressage NZ reserves the right not to offer all 5 sections dependent on nominations received.

**Nominations Close Date:** Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> October on EvoEvents (No nomination fee)

**Selections & Reserve list:** Notified by 7th October

**Selected riders must enter unless a vet or Dr Certificate can be provided**

**Entries:** Close on 16<sup>th</sup> October on Evo Events with Bates Nationals entries  
(\$100 per class plus stabling and other applicable ground fees)

Riders are able to enter the Bates Nationals prior to selection confirmation for the WDC in order to book stables and plan ahead. Once selected, WDC entry can be added. Any subsequent change to any Nats class will not attract a change fee

**Qualification Guidelines:** *It is recognised that the 2021/22 season was very disrupted and therefore these are guidelines only. In the case there are excessive nominations the national selectors will have the complete discretion to select fields. For the efficient organisation of the event, selected combinations must enter unless a vet or Dr certificate is available*

1. **Combinations** should **where possible** have competed in a graded class at the Level nominated between 1 January 2021 and 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2022 at Local, Regional or National Events and be able to demonstrate a minimum **total score as follows**  
**Youth Class 1 63% in levels 2-3; 58% in level 4 or above, Senior Class 2 63 %; Classes 3, 4 & 5 60%**
2. Grading points and all eligibility restrictions ***as at date of close of nominations 2/10/22***
3. Once selections are made, **a combination may apply to move up a level** if they requalify at the new level prior to the event. This application must be made no later than Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November by emailing [dressage@nzequestrian.org.nz](mailto:dressage@nzequestrian.org.nz) **Applications after this date will not be accepted**
4. All riders must be current full ESNZ members at date of nomination
5. All horses and ponies must have a current annual start for Dressage

6. FEI Horse & Rider Registration is not required
7. Rider nationality must be entered in notes on EvoEvents
8. All Fees will be payable at time of entry. (Deadline 16<sup>th</sup> October on Bates Nationals/EvoEvents )
9. No prize money awarded.
10. Winners rugs & rosettes, rosettes for all competitors.
11. All Classes \$100.00 per horse. All riders complimentary Thursday Livamol Team Announcement & Draw function. Attendance compulsory
12. Rider attendance at Judges Review on Thursday late afternoon is compulsory
13. Stabling /camping requirements will be co-ordinated with Dressage NZ Bates Nationals for competitors competing in both events

#### Rider Age:

1. **Youth:** Riders from beginning of calendar year in which rider turns 12yrs until end of calendar year in which they reach 16yrs<sup>[1<sup>st</sup> SEP]</sup>
2. **Seniors:** From beginning of calendar year in which a rider turns 16 years<sup>[1<sup>st</sup> SEP]</sup> Ponies may be ridden in all sections

- 1 **YOUTH 12 -16 years** (NZL approx Level 3/4)  
FEI Children Team Competition Test ED 2022 No restriction on grade of horse or pony but combinations should have qualified at Novice level or above.  
Minimum age horse / pony 6yrs
- 2 **SENIOR I CLASS** (NZL approx Level 3/4) Senior Riders only  
FEI Children Individual Competition Test ED 2022  
Horses / ponies may not have 30 or more Advanced Medium (Level 5) or above pts at 02/10/22
- 3 **SENIOR II CLASS** (NZL approx Level 5) Senior Riders only  
FEI Junior Team Competition Test ED 2022. May qualify in Advanced Medium or Advanced  
Horses/ponies may not have 30 or more pts in Advanced (Level 6) or above at 02/10/22
- 4 **FEI PRIX ST GEORGES: ED 2022** Senior Riders only.  
Combinations **must not have** earned 65% or more in Medium Tour (Level 8) in any graded national or international competition in the 2021 or 2022 calendar years
- 5 **LIVAMOL FEI INTERMEDIATE I: ED 2022 Senior Riders only**  
Combinations **must not have** earned 65% or more in Medium Tour (Level 8) in any graded national or international competition in the 2021 or 2022 calendar years
