Two Fabulous Team Competitions AND You Can Enter Both!



Kamahi Trophy Team Competition (Donated by John & Wendy Farnell)

- This is a distance competition, and the goal is the most kilometres (km's) completed.
- Teams consist of up to six riders. The top four riders scores count towards the Kamahi Trophy.
- Rider must be a current ESNZ member and a member of an ESNZ Endurance affiliated club.
- Each rider can only join one team in this competition.
- Any horse can contribute provided it has the correct registration and qualification for the relevant ride being counted.
- Riders can have completions count on more than one horse at an event.
- Teams can be formed at any time through the season, however no rides for the team count prior to registration of the team on Evo Events.
- Riders will earn points at any ESNZ rides they complete between 1st August and 1st May for the season.
- Points are awarded for distances completed e.g., 40 for 40 km, 80 for 80 km.
- There will be a special Participation Award that combines the number of times all six team members: a) complete a ride and/or b) contribute a day as an official or volunteer. One point awarded for each. Team with the most points wins.
- Teams can be made up of any combination of riders, North Island, South Island, Senior, Junior, Open, Intermediate, Novice & CTR- We want maximum participation!

CTR Team Competition

- Teams consist of three horse/rider combinations. Select a team name.
- Each individual combination can ride in any class of CTR event, except lead rein.
- Rider must be a current ESNZ member and a member of an ESNZ Endurance affiliated club.
- Horses do not need to be ESNZ registered.
- Each rider/horse combination can only be in one CTR team and members of the team must belong to the same club.
- The four best scores from each rider/horse combination count towards the overall team score.
- The duration of the competition is the ride season between 1 August 2024 and 1 May 2025.
- Scores will be recorded at all CTR Points events. No requirement for team members to attend same events.
- Points do not accumulate prior to the date the CTR Team is formed and registered with Evo Events.
- The CTR scoring system is in the ESNZ Endurance Supplementary Rules, Annex Two – Points System (CTR Horse & Rider).
- The winning team will be the one with the highest combined score.
- All horses/riders will continue to be governed by the ESNZ Endurance CTR rules, as appropriate (excluding references to the CTR teams competition in those rules, as these rules, for the purpose of the 2024/25 CTR Teams Competition will supersede those).

These team competitions celebrate one of our core values – to be **INCLUSIVE**. We are *Stronger Together* and strive to bring the endurance and CTR community together in the spirit of teamwork, sportsmanship and competition. Get your teams together and have some fun!
