



## **TiES Best Performed Thoroughbred**



- **Land Rover Horse of the Year Show 2023 (Dressage, Jumping, Show Hunter)**
- **New Zealand National Three Day Championships 2023 (Eventing)**

### **Competition Outline**

This is a NEW competition for eligible Thoroughbreds, brought to you by New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing. To be eligible to compete in Best Performed Thoroughbred at either LRHOY or NZ3DE, your Thoroughbred must be registered with New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing and also with Equestrian Sports New Zealand. Your TB will need to be a Fully Registered ESNZ Horse, including having a Discipline Annual Start for the appropriate discipline.

#### **Points/Scoring:**

For the TiES Best Performed Thoroughbred (at LRHOY in ESNZ competition): prizes will be given to the highest placing Thoroughbred in each competition in its discipline - Jumping, Show Hunter and Dressage - under ESNZ's competition scoring. There is no limit to the number of points which can be collected here, provided they are compliant with what is outlined on page 2.

For the TiES Best Performed Thoroughbred (at NZ 3DE Championships): prizes will be given to the highest placed Thoroughbred (combined overall) in each of the 1\*-4\* Championship Classes.

## Eligible Classes at LRHOY

### Dressage:

All classes are eligible to accrue points.

### Jumping:

Only Jumping National Series Classes will be eligible for TiES points. The horse can be ridden by different rider as the horse will earn points as opposed to a combination.

### Show Hunter:

Only Show Hunter National Series Classes; Junior, Amateur, Open Horse High Points will be eligible for TiES points and Horses must score 66% or over.

The horse can be ridden by different rider as the horse will earn points as opposed to a combination.

## Points Allocation

Points will be allocated as per TiES points.

The points that the thoroughbred gains in the series classes will be the points allocated for TiES. Individual horses may gain points in more than one series class.

TiES Registered Horses will be not be placed independently, this is to reflect the thoroughbred's performance as well as participation.

In the event of a tie then the placings shall be decided by a count back of the highest placings of the rounds that incurred points for the Event.
