



## Show Hunter

### 2021/2022 Competition Outline

#### **Eligible Classes**

Only Show Hunter National Series Classes; Junior, Amateur, Open Horse High Points will be eligible for TiES points and Horses must score 66% or over and must be placed in the first 5 of the class.

The horse can be ridden by different rider as the horse will earn points as opposed to a combination.

If a combined Junior and Amateur High Point Series are run, points will be awarded separately to Junior and Amateur Horses.

#### **Points Allocation**

Points will be allocated as per the ESNZ Show Hunter Rules.

TiES Points will mirror the placing gained in the series class e.g. if a horse comes 1<sup>st</sup> – 6 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 3 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> – 2 pts and 5<sup>th</sup> - 1 pt.

The points that the thoroughbred gains in the series classes will be the points allocated for TiES. Individual horses may gain points in more than one series class.

TiES Registered Horses will be not be placed independently, this is to reflect the thoroughbred's performance as well as participation.

In the event of a tie then the placings shall be decided by a count back of the highest placings of the rounds that incurred points for the season.

#### **Series Period**

The TiES Competition starts from the first Show Hunter Show of the season offering series classes and ends on 27 February 2022, point's allocation will stop after this date.
