Dressage/Para Dressage - with up to 120 riders	First aider or first responder with access to a fully equipped first aid kit; Rapid Response Vehicle.	OC can use volunteer services or *EMT with RRV = \$95.00 per hour
Dressage/Para Dressage - with over 120 riders	Emergency Medical Technician with access to a fully equipped EMT kit plus First aider or first responder with access to a fully equipped first aid kit; Rapid Response Vehicle.	*EMT with RRV = \$95.00 per hour *Ambulance Option = \$150 per hour
Endurance - up to 50 riders per day	First aider or first responder with access to a fully equipped first aid kit; Rapid Response Vehicle.	OC can use volunteer services or *EMT with 4wd RRV = \$95.00 per hour
Endurance - over 50 riders per day	At least two first aiders or first responders with access to fully equipped first aid kits; Rapid Response Vehicle.	OC can use volunteer services or *EMT with 4wd RRV = \$95.00 per hour
Eventing – Jumping and Dressage	Emergency Medical Technician with access to a fully equipped EMT kit; and additional personnel with at least first aid certificate; and a Response Vehicle	*EMT with RRV = \$175.00 per hour. Second officer Ambulance certified FR or Paramedic student on placement.
Eventing – XC	Paramedic and ambulance plus additional personnel as per Eventing Jumping and Dressage phases, and Emergency Medical Technician at minimum.	*Registered Paramedic and EMT plus Ambulance = \$195.00 per hour. Critical Care Paramedic = \$150.00 per hour extra Doctor (FACEM) = \$200.00 per hour
Jumping/SH – up to 100 riders	First aider or first responder with access to a fully equipped first aid kit and a Medical Station.	OC can use volunteer services *EMT with RRV \$150.00 per hour
Jumping/SH – over 100 riders	Emergency Medical Technician with access to a fully equipped EMT kit plus First aider or first responder with access to a fully equipped first aid kit; Rapid Response Vehicle	*EMT with RRV = \$175.00 per hour Second officer Ambulance certified FR or Paramedic student on placement.

Travel time for an RRV or Ambulance to a venue is charged ex Base location at \$75.00 per hour. Bases are Auckland, Waikato, Bay of Plenty, Christchurch, and Southland.

We reserve the right to send a Paramedic to an EMT level event if our booking levels dictate at no extra charge.

Discretion of club supplied First aid personnel- where a club can provide a volunteer person as a first aider, it is preferred the person be a registered Nurse or firefighter, allied health professional with appropriate currency in practice, urgent care scope, and licensure. Transitcare staff remain person in charge unless a Doctor of Medicine on site assumes responsibility for care of the patient in writing at the scene. A discount for this person will be applied at \$25 per hour on the basis this is pre-advised to Transitcare 7 days before the event.

Transitcare does not recognize NZCEC/PHEC holders as appropriate to practice unsupervised pursuant to risks within this sport and mechanisms of potential injury. Transitcare Officers start at EMT level, and FR level staff generally are Paramedic students in the final phase of Diploma Study on working placement.

Transitcare does not accept liability for club provided first aid persons in terms of the Children and Vulnerable persons legislation and club due diligence is recommended. All staff are Police checked and hold registration and practicing certificates to national bodies.

Airline travel for staff is charged at cost, we book through our in-house travel agent well in advance and get special pricing as we are an aviation company with ties to the airlines.

Accommodation is on a cost recovery basis, and we are geared up for camping and back-country operations with our 4wd touring vehicles.
