History

NZ riders have a rich history of team and individual success in this competition in both the Zone 9 and World Rankings

The aim of this competition is to give the less experienced Dressage riders who, under normal circumstances, cannot take part in international Dressage competitions and live in the more remote countries, the opportunity to compete internationally without having to leave their own country. Creating a “bridge” between the National level and the first FEI level of competitions but aiming to develop the discipline as a whole in a country by creating more opportunities for officials to gain experience while working in close collaboration with FEI Judges. The event offers a world individual and regional classification per level, in the team classification a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 team athletes can be nominated, the team members’ final results, expressed in percentages, will be added. The results achieved by the three best team athletes will count for the team classification. Scores obtained at higher technical levels will have a higher coefficient, this may impact the overall results and the team selection process.

The event also serves as an educational purpose by linking the competition with the coaching. The Dressage tests are in correlation with the Levels 1, 2 and 3 of the FEI Coach Education System. National Federations that have applied through the FEI Solidarity for an Equestrian Sport Educative Event in Dressage have the possibility to link the competition to the education of their National officials, which is another important tool aimed towards the development of the discipline.

The event is held between the 1 January and the 31 December each year and 2023 sees the FEI Dressage World Challenge entering its 43rd edition.

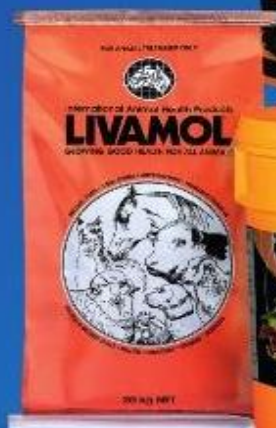
