3.3 HOY 2021 Draft Schedule and requests

MT discussed the key points:

- Reduced the number of jumping rings from 4 down to 3 (premier arena + 2 other arenas)
- All Series class finals are to be in the premier arena
- 2 classes have been removed from the schedule due to consistently low entries
- HOY wish to include a specific number (eg 8 or 10) to bring back for the jump-off in the schedule
 - Under the rule changes from technical, the addition of Art 273 into the rider series, they will be able to do so without needing any dispensation.
- Saba Sam, reduce the height listed in the schedule to 1.15-1.20 (from 1.15-1.20) due to lack of ponies competing at the 1.25 height.
- Board felt they needed more time to thoroughly look through the schedule

4. ITEMS FOR DISCUSION

4.1. FEI Discussion – Expense Claims for Road mileage

MB discussed removing expense claims for road travel to FEI events and using this money to pay for organising dues, calendar fees, etc instead. Move to next meeting (14^{th} July).

Discussed the TAG HUER timers being more portable rather than having to be in the Freeway Float.

Having the timers in the Freeway Float is the best option as the Float holds all the necessary gear for FEI classes, making it easier to keep track of. (screen, mat, printers, FEI cups) Board discussed what version the timers are and whether they need upgrading.
