ESNZ MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

CCN1* and above	<p><u>Rider</u> - Full ESNZ rider membership required.</p> <p><u>Equine</u> - Full Equine registration required plus Discipline starts.</p>
CCN105 and above	<p><u>Rider</u> - Full ESNZ Rider membership required.</p> <p><u>Equine</u> – Must have at least ESNZ Equine casual registration (as long as you do not wish to enter a National series or have your results recorded) or Full Equine Registration. If equine has casual registration, ESNZ Eventing Flexi Start fee is also payable on entry.</p>
CCN95	<p><u>Rider</u> - Full or introductory membership.</p> <p><u>Equine</u> - Must have at least ESNZ Equine casual registration (as long as you do not wish to enter a National series or have your results recorded) or Full Equine Registration.</p>
CCN80	<p><u>Rider</u> – Full, introductory, or casual membership.</p> <p><u>Equine</u> – Must have at least ESNZ Equine casual registration (as long as you do not wish to enter a National series or have your results recorded) or Full Equine Registration.</p>
CCN65	<p><u>Rider</u> – Full, introductory, or casual membership.</p> <p><u>Equine</u> – Not required.</p>



DID YOU KNOW – at this Horse Trial, it is not compulsory for every rider to provide a cross country jump judge? This is a great advantage to those who are on their own. Of course, we will not turn down offers of help and there are always things that can be done (SJ pole picking up, SJ pack up etc). But cross country day is yours to enjoy!

General Event Conditions & Information

- Classes may be split into age groups if entry levels permit.
- Draw will be emailed via EvoEvents.
- Farrier will be on-call. Details will be at the office.
- Waikato Equine Veterinary Centre on-call for Saturday. Will be on site Sunday.
- No non-competing horses will be permitted on site.
- The event will be run under ESNZ eventing rules – effective 1 August 2024 and is part of the NRM Eventing National Series Competition. The OC reserve the right to restrict entries, if necessary, alter classes & prize money as required – article 611 – Reservation of Right.
- Combinations with 2 MERs from 2 levels above (2* for the 95 and 3* for the 105) will need to ride HC.
Note: a MER = Over 55% in dressage, clear jumping & not more than 30-time penalties in X country, & not more than 16 jump faults in SJ – Reference to rule 613 – 11b at www.nzequestrian.org.nz for further clarification.
- **Dogs**- must be on a **lead at all times**, and are not allowed in any of the competition areas i.e. they must stay in the carpark only. The OC would prefer that dogs were left at home.
- **Internet Banking** use: 03 0314 0183823 01, note “riders name” & “HT” as reference.
- **Prize giving** - Prize money awarded s per Article 619. Overall rosettes to 6th place, prizegiving details will be announced Sunday am. *** Prize money may be substituted with sponsor’s product to the same value. Weather dependant – the Winners of each class will be required mounted to accept their prize. 2nd-6th can collect from the office unmounted. This will be announced further on the day.
- **Refunds/Scratchings** – All scratchings to be done through EvoEvents. Scratchings must be notified immediately as laid out in the wording of ESNZ Article 646 – Withdrawals and Substitutions. No refund on Admin, EvoEvents and Late entry fees. REFUNDS – to be read in conjunction with Article 606 “an Event” – scratching from the event 49 hours before the start of competition (before 7.00am Thursday 30th January 2025) will be entitled to an 80% refund of entry fees on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate. No refunds for whatever reason after 7.01am on the 30th of January 2025. Queries and requests for refunds including vet and medical certificates need to be emailed to the secretary before 9th of February 2025 to qualify for a refund. Refunds will be processed between the completion of the event and the 23rd of February 2025. No refunds will be investigated or paid after this date.
- **Refreshments** – available on grounds – DeeJays will be on site from Friday PM. Little Cherry Coffee will be on site from Saturday morning.
- **Timetable** – Dressage Saturday, SJ Saturday (blackboard order), XC on Sunday (back no. order)
- **Back number holders** are required (available at most local horse shops)
- **Yards** – Any broken or damaged yards or dirty yards will be charged to the rider accordingly. Yarding will be allocated.
- **Late Entries/Payments** – May be accepted at OC discretion and only if payment can be made by PoliPay. Unpaid fees owed to other WECT events must be settled before your entry will be accepted and put into the draw.
- **Cancellation due to Covid-19** – If in the OC’s reasonable opinion, a change in the Covid-19 restrictions and/or alert level statue in New Zealand after close of entries and prior to the start of the event causes event cancellation or amendment, a minimum of 50% of entry fees will be refunded.
- **Photos** – please note that our official photographer and WECT staff take photos for Facebook and advertising purposes. These may be used by WECT without further reference to competitors unless you specially request not to be included in photos of this type.
- **The Rider Shop/Rangiora Equestrian XC Style Prize** – Will be awarded at this show - Judged at 105 and below for riders that are uncategorised. To encourage good, safe cross country riding.
