## Championship Classes Requirement

- Riders in all Championship classes must be financial members of an affiliated club and have a current ESNZ membership as an Introductory, Full, Child or Visiting Rider member
- Unregistered horses may compete in championship classes
- Before entering an Open CTR of 60km or longer the horse and rider (not necessarily as a combination) must first have qualified in two CTR competitions 40-59km or two endurance competitions 40km or longer within the preceding 24 months

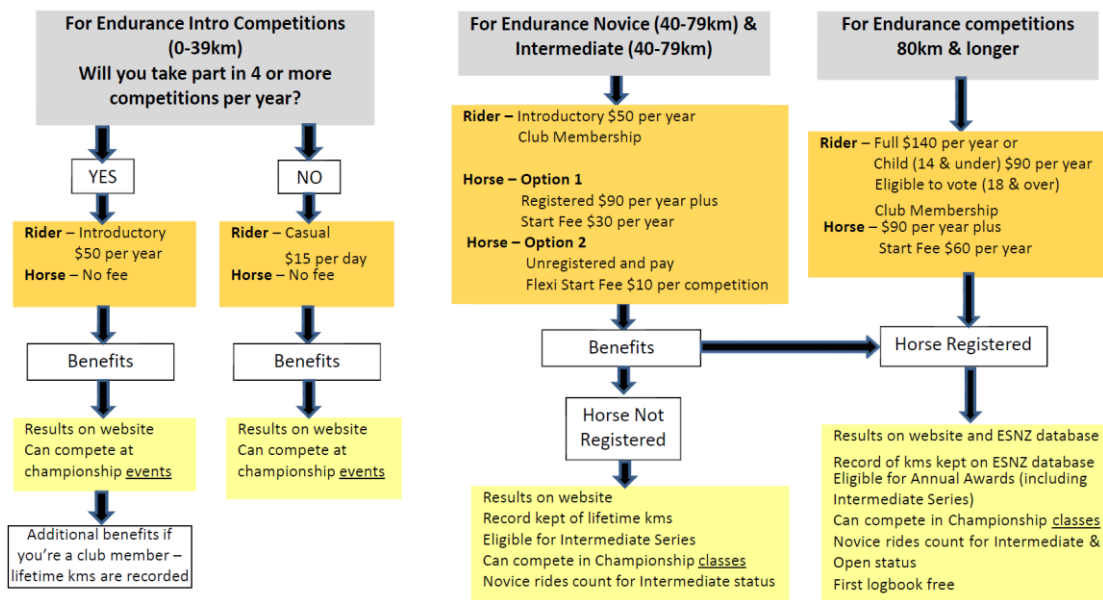
## Directions

- Go to Masterton
- Get onto the Castlepoint turnoff, which is at the Northern end of Masterton, by the Mobil service station
- Head past the hospital and travel approx 4 kms until the Bidiford, Pongoroa turnoff on your left,
- Travel approx 3kms until you reach Black Rock Road on you left
- Follow Black Rock Road approx 5 kms until you get to the end of the road
- Black Rock Station - travel over cattle-stop and keep going until you reach a second cattle stop
- Drive past woolshed over small bridge and you are in the ride base
