From North

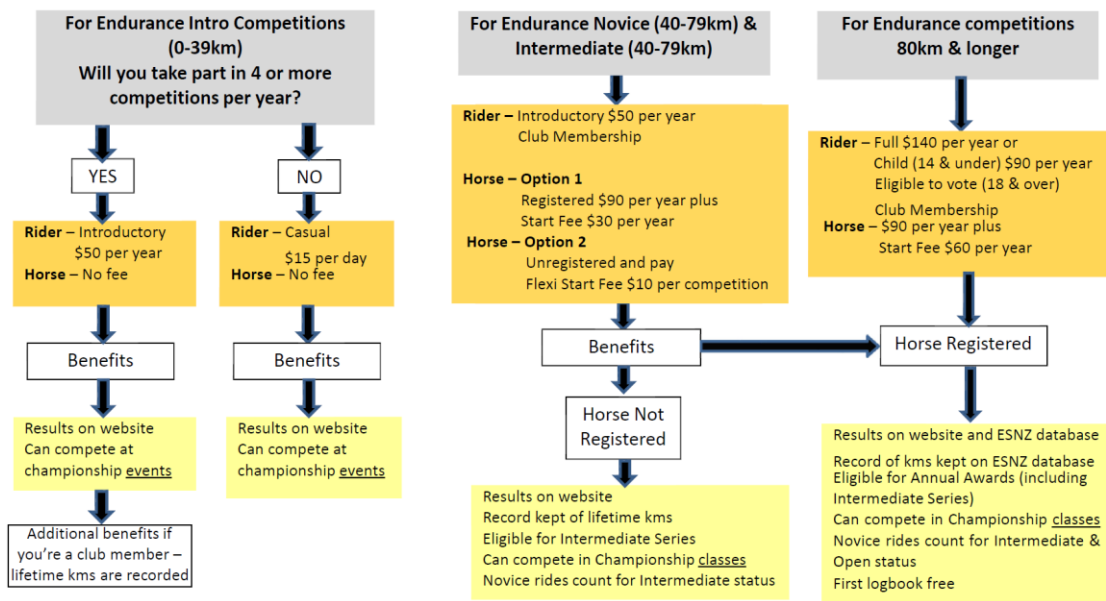
- Travel through Greytown and go towards Featherston
- Turn left before Tin Hut Hotel onto No 1 Line.
- Cross straight over Martinborough - Featherston highway towards Kahutara.
- Travel another 25km towards Pirinoa.
- Yeronga Road is 1km north of Pirinoa on the left. It will be signposted.
- At junction veer right into Humes Road.

From Wellington

- From Wellington turn onto Featherston - Martinborough highway
- Travel over Tauherinakau river
- 1 km past river turn right towards Kahutara.
- Follow above directions from there
