COVID-19 PLANNING

We are guided by the government with regard to the national pandemic response. In order to enable us to be in a position to proceed at Covid-19 Alert Level 2, we are having to change the format of our event this year and will be implementing additional health and safety measures and processes. Should it be that we are at Alert Level 1 at the time of our event, you should assume that the same applies unless we advise otherwise.

Everyone attending our event (riders, support people and officials) are required to respect and adhere to these rules in order to enable us to run. In entering, you agree to take responsibility for your own health and safety in line with the national guidance and adhere to the following (and any additional measures we put in place):

- Saturday 20th November: 105, 105+ and 65 cm will compete in all three phases
 - Bubble A: 105cm
 - Bubble B: 65cm
- Sunday 21st November: 80 and 95 cm will compete in all three phases
 - Bubble A: 95cm
 - Bubble B: 80cm
- Each bubble will have separate parking, yarding, toilet facilities and will have separate times allocated to each phase (except where a truck/float has multiple competitors)
- If the event is cancelled, any paid fees (excluding the Admin Fee) will be refunded.
- Every competitor may bring **only** 1 support person/groom & no spectators will be allowed.
- Entries may be limited to ensure adherence to gathering restrictions.
- Every rider (or their support person) is required to provide some assistance – either via practice days or XC fence judging
- Overnight camping will be available, but limited. You will be allocated a day yard which you are required to use to assist us with limited parking and to manage the bubbles.
- There will be limited access to the day secretary
- Riders will be asked to print their own back numbers and programmes
- The XC Course Opening Time is yet to be advised – refer to our FB Page
- There will not be a mounted presentation
- To run this way, we are incurring substantial additional costs, and so there will be an extra fee of \$10.00 per rider to help cover this.
- We will have an updated Frequently Asked Questions Page on our Facebook page – please refer to that for any questions regarding format or Covid 19 rather than messaging our Event Secretary.

Entry Conditions

- Bank Account for internet banking: 03-0687-0318743-00, Eventing Wairarapa.
- Entries, including fees must be received by the Secretary by midnight **Thursday 11th November 2021**. Entries and/or Fees received after this time, if accepted (at Secretary's discretion) will incur the Late Fee & their entry will not be refundable.
- Classes 1 – 4 are part of ESNZ Eventing National Series Competitions
- Draw will be posted on www.evoevents.co.nz from Wed 18th November.
- All riders **MUST** provide name and phone number for a XC fence judge, helping at event or at working bees (see dates below). Entries will not be accepted without this name.
- Working Bee dates: Sat 6th (pm), Sat 13th Nov (pm) & Fri 19th Nov (pm).
- Dogs are welcome, but they must be kept on leads and supervised at all times. Any wandering or unsupervised dogs will be handed over to the Carterton District Council Dog Control at the owner's expense. No warnings will be issued.
- Refreshments available on grounds, subject to Covid-19 protocols.
- Run under current ESNZ Eventing Rules – <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/Eventing-Rules-Revision-August-2021-version-7.0-final-clean-copy-1-1.pdf>. Of particular note:
 - Dressage Tests may be called for CCN 80 and CCN 65.
 - Scratchings & Refunds (Article 646): Entry fee less 20% and Admin Fee refunded, if scratching in writing received by Secretary by 9am Thursday 19th November 2021. Refunds under \$10 will not be paid.
 - MER restrictions: A Combination must compete "Hors Concours" (HC) in any class if the combination has two MERs achieved at 2 levels above the class (except for 105+ class).
 - Back number holders are required for all phases
 - Body protectors that meet minimum standards are compulsory for XC ◦
 - ESNZ Helmet rules apply;
 - Article 611 The Organizing Committee reserves the right to alter the program as required, including splitting classes
 - Prize money will be paid out at a ratio 1:5 starters but may be substituted with sponsor's prizes to the value or part thereof for classes 1-2. Prize Money to be paid out by Direct Credit, per bank acc details on EvoEvents
 - Liability: Article 610: **Neither the Organizer of any event to which these rules apply nor the NF nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.**
