- All classes to run over both days – Dressage & SJ Sat, XC Sun
- **Entries close Friday 3rd November.** Entries and/or Fees received after this time, if accepted, will incur the Late Fee.
- Young Rider & Junior Championship Classes will run as part of classes 1 & 2 - please indicate on entry if you would like to enter those title classes
- Young Rider Conditions of Entry:
 - An Athlete may compete as a Young Rider from the beginning of the calendar year in which the Athlete reaches the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which the Athlete reaches the age of 21.
 - Must have a Qualifying Result in either a CCI2*-S or a CCN3*-S in the preceding 2 calendar years.
- Class 2 Junior Rider Condition of Entry:
 - An Athlete may compete as a Junior from the beginning of the calendar year in which the Athlete reaches the age of 14 until the end of the calendar year in which the Athlete reaches the age of 18.
- Classes 3 & 4 may be merged depending on numbers
- Classes 5, 6 & 7 may be split by age if numbers suffice

GENERAL TERMS & INFORMATION

- ESNZ Eventing National Series points will apply – refer to ESNZ Eventing website
- Draw will be posted on www.evoevents.co.nz from Wed 15th November 2023. You will be expected to print your own back numbers.
- **We will be relying upon EVERY RIDER to fence judge or to provide a XC fence judge.** As a competitor, you will be allocated class(es) to fence judge, unless you provide the name and phone number of a person that can fence judge on your behalf on entry.
- No dogs allowed.
- Refreshments available on grounds.
- There will be a prize-giving at completion - first place-getters to be mounted.
- Please clean out yards any report any damage to the Yarding Manager.
- Please expressly state upon entry if you are planning to stay Sunday night for H&S purposes
- Run under current ESNZ Eventing Rules. Of particular note:
 - Any fall of an athlete during the jumping test at all levels will result in elimination. (Art 672.1 and Art 672.2)
 - Riders who leave the event following a fall without being checked by medical team will receive a verbal warning & could receive additional sanctions (Art 634.3)
 - After a fall on XC, riders may not remount until checked by medical (Art 634.4)
 - Dressage Tests may be called for CCN 80 and CCN 65.
 - Scratchings & Refunds (Article 646): Refunds will be total fee less 20% and Admin Fee (Refund = EF – (20% EF + AF)), if scratching in writing received by Event Secretary by 9am Thursday 16th November 2023. Refunds under \$10 will not be paid.
 - MER restrictions: A Combination must compete “Hors Concours” (HC) in any class if the combination has two MERs achieved at 2 levels above the class.
 - Back numbers must be worn at all times whilst mounted for exercise or schooling
 - Please check standards for body protectors for XC & (ESNZ rules) for Helmets;
 - We reserve the right to alter the program, including splitting classes (Art 611)
 - Prize money will be paid out at a ratio 1:5 starters & by Direct Credit.
 - Liability: Article 610: **Neither the Organizer of any event to which these rules apply nor the NF nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.**

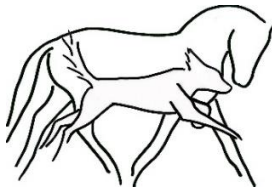
