### Ride Base

- Ride base is situated at 1220 Nenthorn Road, Macraes Flat
- All yards must conform to ESNZ standards.
- All hold yards must conform to ESNZ standards and you will be advised where these can be set up
- All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times while on ride base
- No dogs allowed.
- Last fuel station is at Dunback (Highway 85)
- Last shop is the Palmerston Four Square
- Ride Base opens on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March at 12pm
- North Island travellers or riders from afar are able to PM Susie Latta for early arrival arrangements if needed

### Directions to Venue

#### Travelling from the South:

- From Palmerston turn left onto Dunback Highway 85 (15.4km). Turn left onto Macraes Road (signs for Macraes Flat/Middelmarch) (21.5km). Turn left onto Nenthorn Road (12.1km)

#### Travelling from the North:

- From Palmerston turn right onto Dunback Highway 85 (15.4km). Turn left onto Macraes Road (signs for Macraes Flat/Middelmarch) (21.5km). Turn left onto Nenthorn Road (12.1km)

### Definite Entries

- Definite entries close 18.3.21 and all fees must be paid by this date.
- If you didn't nominate and still want to enter, you can do so, but as well as filling in a definite entry form, you still need to nominate also so we have a record of all details
- Entries cannot be taken at the event.
- A late fee of \$30 per entry will apply to all entries and payments received after 18.3.21

### Yarding & Camping

- Camping is available at the venue but is non-powered only.
- Portaloos and Showers will be available from Wednesday 31.3.21. A small ground fee will be charged per entry to cover the cost of Showers and Rubbish Collection
- There will be one location only available to dispose of rubbish. It would be appreciated if locals and those with not far too travel could take their own rubbish home with them

- A water tank will be available from Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> for those arriving prior to Friday.
