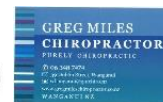

SHOW TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Important: Entry to the oval is via Anson Street off Carlton Avenue. Please note that due to track work the Anson Street gate is not opened until 8.15am on Saturday morning. Arriving too early on Saturday will cause a traffic jam on a major bypass.

Entries

Entries are accepted through Main Events website, by post to Wanganui A&P Association, PO Box 25, Wanganui, or scanned and emailed to Wanganuishow@gmail.com. All entries are to be submitted on our official entry form. No entries will be accepted by fax. Entries will not be accepted or processed until payment has been received. On-line payments can be made to 02 0792 0019868 00. Please state your name as a reference. Entries close 2 November 2018. After this date a 50% late entry fee will be applied, no exceptions. Class changes during the show will incur a \$3 fee. Catalogues are \$5 and can be ordered when entering and collected from the Secretary's office. Ground levy of \$10 per horse. Rider levy of \$15 per rider. This includes the rider first aid levy.

Prize Money

All prize money will be paid out within two weeks of the show to the bank account number on your Main Events account. Prize money will be paid in full regardless of entry numbers. All prizes and prize money are GST inclusive.

Refunds and Scratchings

The Association will refund 80% of entry fees if scratchings or withdrawals occur on or before 8 November 2018. A valid explanation must be given. Refunds will be posted out after the show.

Horse of the Year Qualifying Show

The Wanganui A&P Show is a qualifying show for Horse of the Year.

Access and Camping

Camping is available on the racecourse Friday and Saturday nights. A camping fee of \$15/truck or float applies. Jockey club showers are available. Parking or camping near the stables is not allowed. All access to the oval is via Anson Street.

Parking

The Clearways allow for competitor/spectator/emergency and staff access. All designated Clearways marked by cones are to be kept free of parked vehicles during the running of the show.

Head Wear

Red Tagged helmets are to be worn at all times when mounted.

Yards & Stables

These are available Friday and Saturday nights. Loose Boxes are \$40 and Uncovered Yards are \$30 for the duration of the show. Booking is essential. No temporary fence accommodation is permitted. Yard allocation will be emailed out prior to the show. Please leave your yards and boxes clean. A fine of \$30 will be imposed on yards and boxes that are not mucked out. There is no refund of cancelled entries for yards as we will have already booked, transported and paid for them.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome. Please ensure they are supervised at all times and kept on leads during show hours. A Pet Parade has been organized for Saturday night. There is \$350 worth of dog food to be won in prizes, generously sponsored by MainFeeds. Pets of all denominations are welcome to the Pet Parade.

Saturday Night Get Together

All competitors, sponsors and spectators are invited to a Get Together on Saturday night. Time to be advised on the day. Meals are \$5 and alcohol will be available. There will be a Pet Parade (\$350 worth of dog food kindly sponsored by MainFeeds to be won) and Children's Games.

Class 284, Who Shot Thebarman - Top Jumping Thoroughbred – Conditions and Points system

This is a points award to be judged over all jumping classes, including Show Jumping and Show Hunter, but excluding Show Jumping Ring Three and Introductory Show Hunter classes. The top point scorer wins a rug kindly donated by Lynette O'Leary, and \$150. Other PM is 70, 30, 10. Points will be awarded as follows: Six points to first placing, five to second, four to third and so on for Ring One series classes. Four points to first place, three to second and so on for Ring One non-series classes and also for Ring Two and Show Hunter. A multiplier of 1.75 will then be applied to the total of any points earned in Ring One. A multiplier of 1.25 will also be applied to the total of any points earned in Ring Two. The winner must be available on Sunday at the end of the show to receive their rug or they forfeit their placing. This class is only open to registered branded thoroughbreds.

Classes 314 and 319, Harcourts Pony Challenge Points Prize 1m – Points system

Placing gained in the rounds jumped in class 314 and class 319 count towards an overall points prize. The winner of this receives \$100 and a rug, kindly sponsored by Mark Morton of Harcourts. 1st place = 4 points, 2nd place = 3 points, 3rd place = 2 points and 4th place = 1 point. Where placings result in equal points jump off speeds will determine the overall winner.

Classes 317 and 324, Harcourts Horse Challenge Points Prize 1.10m – Points system

Places gained in the rounds jumped in class 317 and class 324 count towards an overall points prize. The winner of this receives \$150 and a rug, kindly sponsored by Mark Morton of Harcourts. 1st place = 4 points, 2nd place = 3 points, 3rd place = 2 points and 4th place = 1 point. Where placings result in equal points jump off speeds will determine the overall winner.

Class 283, Sonya Glennie Horse Show Hunter Champion Points Prize - Conditions

This class will be awarded based on the average of the score of two rounds, being the round jumped in class 283, and the competitor's best score in any previous class. Classes 274 and 275 are not eligible for consideration. The winner receives a rug and \$150.

Class 299, Sonya Glennie Pony Show Hunter Champion Points Prize - Conditions

This class will be awarded based on the average of the score of two rounds, being the round jumped in class 299, and the competitor's best score in any previous class at the show. Classes 285, 290 and 295 are not eligible for consideration. The winner receives a rug and \$100.

RAS

The RAS Equestrian Rulebook (www.ras.org.nz) sets out all conditions applying to showing classes offered.

All entry fees include a \$1 RAS levy.

RAS Height Certificates/Novice Performance Cards must be carried at all times and presented on request. No card – no start. No exceptions.

Yellow Card - This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow Card will be issued, in cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz.

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the responsible person's risk.

Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardiovascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

Arrears -No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

Summary of RAS Resolution Process – the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to an RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.

ESNZ

All jumping classes are run under ESNZ rules. With the exception of Introductory classes all riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership. Horses registered with ESNZ but NOT currently registered for Jumping/Show Hunter (excluding Introductory level) must pay the ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy of \$20 per show for all non-series classes. Height restrictions of Horses:1.10m and Ponies 1m apply. Riders must have full ESNZ membership. All horses/ponies must pay an ESNZ \$5 jumping levy.

Show Hunter

All Show Hunter will be run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2018 and Equitation Series Conditions 2018. Please refer to ESNZ web site for Show Hunter Rule changes. Our stewards will be enforcing these. Equines competing in series classes must have full ESNZ Registration and a Current Annual Jumping/Show Hunter Start. Equines competing using the ESNZ Jumping Casual Levy cannot compete in any Show Hunter Series Classes. Introductory classes do not carry HOY qualifying points. Classes may be run back to back.

Health and Safety

We will take responsibility for Health and Safety procedures, however all people on this site need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the events Health and Safety policy. Competitors will be responsible for themselves at all times by observing safe practices/instructions relating to their competition.

By entering the Wanganui A&P Show (The Event) all competitors are understood to have agreed with the following statements.

I declare that:

1. My accepted entry into the Event will not be transferred to another entrant.
2. In the event of any 'act of God' conditions causing a cancellation of the Event, I agree that my total entry fee is not transferable or refundable.
3. I am in an appropriate physical condition to participate in the Event, given the known parameters of the Event (such as the length, time, physical demands and environmental context).
4. I have taken medical advice on any pre-existing medical conditions, and confirm that it is medically safe for me to participate in the Event.
5. I acknowledge that there are risks involved in the Event. I fully realise the dangers of participating in the Event, and fully assume the risks associated with my participation and my wellbeing and safety during and after the Event. I understand and acknowledge that the Event organisers (including all officials and event volunteers) provide no warranties, regarding my wellbeing and safety.
6. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the Event, which may be beyond the immediate control of the Event organisers (including all officials and event volunteers).
7. I will participate in the Event, in a manner that does not endanger either me or others.
8. I agree that to the extent permissible by law, the Event organisers (including all officials and event volunteers), the sponsors and other parties associated with the Event, have no liability to me whatsoever for any direct or indirect loss, (including, but not limited to injury or death) sustained by me during or in any way related to my participation in the Event.
9. I authorise the use of my name, voice, picture and information on this entry form in any broadcast, telecast, promotion, advertising, and in any other way, without payment to me or any other form of compensation.
10. I agree to comply with the rules, and regulations pertaining to the Event.
11. I agree to follow all reasonable safety instructions provided to me by the Event organisers, (including all officials and event volunteers) before, during and after the Event.
12. I consent to receiving medical treatment in the event of illness or injuries suffered during or immediately after the Event.

Legal Liability

Our Association's Public Liability Policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors.

Protests

Protests must be lodged in writing with the secretary no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event concerned. A deposit of \$50 must accompany each protest. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Quad Bikes

Quad Bikes/and or any motorised Bikes - All riders must wear a helmet at all times. This is inclusive of pillion passengers. No more than one pillion passenger is allowed per bike. Speed is restricted to no more than 10kms per hour. All drivers of ANY bike must hold the appropriate licenses/endorsements to operate the vehicle. No quads in the narrow accessways between yards.

Stallions

All stallions and colts must wear a bit at all times other than when stabled. When not competing stallions must be stabled. It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS Head Office. Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring.

Mares

A 'Dry' mare is a mare not to foal during the current show season (1 August to 31 July).

Mares shown in Brood Mare classes must have a foal at foot or present a veterinary certificate of pregnancy that includes a projected foaling date. Mares shown in the summer season without a foal at foot, would be expected (before Christmas) to be late foaling in the summer or autumn, or (after Christmas) to have weaned an early foal and be back in foal with a spring due date. Mare falling into either of the above categories should prove their eligibility with a veterinary certificate. Anything less will be unacceptable.

Broodmares with foal at foot are ineligible for ridden classes.

Wanganui Jockey Club

Without the generosity of the WJC we would not be able to have our show. Please respect the following WJC requests: Remove all rubbish to wheelie bins, remove all hay to fire pit near Oval Yards, leave all manure spread on the ground – do not place under running rails or leave in a large heap. If using a motorbike you are restricted to daylight hours only. Drivers must be 14 years and over, helmets must be worn, restricted to 10kph at all times.

Presentation Area

This area has been decorated for the purposes of capturing sponsored presentations and anyone else who wishes to be photographed with their horse, prizes, rugs or trophies. Enjoy it and make the most of it!! For your convenience this area will have a dedicated photographer.
