Queen Elizabeth Park is open to the public.

Riders must be watchful of other park users, and the tram.

Conditions

- 1. Run under ESNZ Evenitng "Express Eventing" Guildines.
- Riders must be members of ESNZ or pay \$15 casual day membership to compete. Horse/ponies do not need to be registered.
- 3. A horse/pony can only compete in ONE class.
- 4. Depending on entries classes may close early and/or be split into 2 divisions. Waitlist if classes fill before closing date.
- Scratchings, withdrawals, and substitutions as per Article 646 of Eventing Rules. EvoEvents on-line entry fee is non refundable.
- 6. **No Vet or Ambulance** on the grounds; riders compete in this knowledge. There will be a First Aider in attendance and any rider who falls off anywhere on the grounds <u>must</u> report to the First Aid Station for checking and incident reporting purposes.
- 7. No refeshments available on site, please bring your own. No Farrier on site.
- 8. No formal Prize Giving, collect ribbons once results show on EvoEvents.
- NO dogs allowed QE Park Rule.
 NO smoking on the the grounds Fire Risk.
- 10. This Express Event does not form part of the ESNZ Eventing series, the Zilco Series or qualify for MERs.

Competition Format

As the name implies *Express* Events are designed so a rider completes an entire class in 45 mins or less (but allow 1 hour). Therefore you must go quickly from the DR to SJ to the XC. As an Express Event is for training purpsoes the SJ and XC course will be shorter and less technical.

- 1. Riders do the Dressage test in their Cross Country attire, <u>except</u> in the Dressage no whips allowed, only a snaffle bit is permitted and back protectors aren't worn. No plaiting.
- 2. Dressage test may be called for the 65cm & 80cm classes only.
- After Dressage riders will <u>only have 10 minutes</u> before they start their Show Jumping round. This 10 minutes is to make any tack changes required, grab a whip and back protector and jump some practice fences.
- Once riders have done their show jumping they <u>must head</u> <u>immediately over</u> to the start of the Cross Country.
 Back Protectors <u>must</u> be worn and should be put on before the Show Jumping.
- 5. Neither the Show Jumping nor the Cross Country will be timed.
- 6. Jump faults will be scored as per ESNZ Eventing rules. Cross Country: Riders <u>must</u> walk home if they have 3 stops at the same jump or 4 stops in total on the course. Fall of rider or horse = elimination. Rider must not continue and must report to the First Aid Station if not already seen by First Aider at at the time of their fall.
- 7. Riders must obey any instructions given to them by officials.
- 8. Spotters will be used instead of fence judges at each fence.
- 9. NO Protests this is a fun event. If you have any issues please come and talk to us.
