- Yards \$15 per horse for the event.
- Changing Class after draw at Entry Secretaries discretion with payment of \$10 Fee (non refundable).
- <u>Late entries</u> may be accepted at Entry Secretaries discretion with payment of \$20 Fee (non refundable).

- Entries only accepted with full payment online. Payments must be shown in bank account by Friday 19 March 2021 any payments received after this date will incur a \$20 late fee.
- <u>Scratchings and requests for refunds</u> as per Article 646 Rules for Eventing.
- By making an entry riders are liable for all fees, even if they do not attend the event. If you subsequently scratch, the refund policy will apply. Non Refundable Fees: Please note that the Medical Levy, Change of Class and Late Entry fees are non-refundable.

Please Note the following Horse & Rider ESNZ Membership Requirements for entry to this Competition

Rider Membership of ESNZ (Equestrian Sport NZ)

Classes 1 to 3...... Riders need to be full ESNZ members.

Classes 4 & 5 Riders need to be full ESNZ members OR an Introductory ESNZ member.

Classes 6 to 9....... Riders need to be a <u>full ESNZ member</u> **OR** an <u>Introductory ESNZ member</u> **OR** a <u>Casual Day member</u> (Casual Rider Membership costs \$15 for the Event– pay with Entry)

Equine Membership of ESNZ (Equestrian Sport NZ)

Classes 1 to 2...... Horse must be registered with ESNZ and have the appropriate Eventing Annual Start for class entered.

Classes 4 to 7 Horses not registered with ESNZ may enter by paying a \$5 Casual Equine Day Registration- pay with Entry.

Classes 8 & 9....... Horses <u>DO NOT</u> have to be registered with ESNZ & <u>DO NOT</u> have to pay a Casual Equine Day Registration.

Timetable:	 Dressage, Show Jumping & Cross country for all classes on one day. For some classes, the cross country phase may run before the show jumping phase. 	
Riders Reps:	Riders Reps – names & contact phone numbers will be advised near the event date	
Prize Giving:	 As per Article 619 ESNZ Eventing Rules. All Classes can collect their rosettes from the Office 30 minutes after final result is posted. Any Prize Money & Refunds will be paid to the rider's bank account so make sure your bank account details are correct in Equestrian Entries. Any uncollected rosettes and prizes will not be posted out given the increasing costs to do so. 	

General Event Conditions & Information:

- a) Disclaimer of Liability. Neither the Organiser of this Event nor ESNZ nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever (Article 610 ESNZ Eventing Rules).
- b) Cross-country Number bibs to be worn in all Phases & Classes. Back Protectors are compulsory for the Cross Country phase and must meet the new standard introduced 1 Aug 2020. Riders must wear approved safety helmets that have been red tagged as meeting the ESNZ Safety Standards. (Safety standards can be found on the ESNZ website).
- c) The committee reserves the right to limit numbers, cancel or change a class or make any other change in terms of Article 611 ESNZ Eventing Rules.
- d) Once a class is full or you are a late entry, you may be wait listed until a scratching occurs.
- e) Draw & Yarding will be emailed to you or you can view the Draw on www.equestrianentries.co.nz
- f) Competitors must comply with the requirements of Article 634 Medical Information and provide telephone number of accompanying person/next of kin for event Secretary, either by having entered it on your Equestrian Entries Profile or notifying the office when picking up Back Number.
- g) Horses and riders must have met the MER to enter classes 1 to 2, see Article 633 of the Eventing Rules https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/Eventing-Rules-2020-Version-6.0.8-Clean-.pdf
- h) Riders who are eliminated in the DR or SJ phase of the competition cannot ride in subsequent phases unless approval has been given by the Technical Delegate. Riders who are eliminated in the cross country phase CANNOT continue the cross country course and must walk home this applies to all classes.
- i) All local riders <u>must</u> provide a phone number or email for a named fence judge or a volunteer to help out with set up and day before or help out on the day this is a condition of entry.
- j) No dogs allowed on the Event areas. Relevant rider may be eliminated if this is ignored. No vehicles allowed on Cross Country course except officials & Cross Country Fence Judges.
- k) Hot and cold refreshments available. Farrier, Vet and Medical cover will be on site.
- I) For compliance with safety requirements all vehicles with horses must park in the designated float/truck area.
- m) No rubbish or manure collection service is available at QE Park. Please take away ALL your rubbish and clean the twine, manure and hay from around your float or truck and it your yard and take it away with you.
